Explore the HERIT ADAPT pilot sites to see theory in action and discover adaptable solutions that support resilient and sustainable tourism practices in diverse contexts.



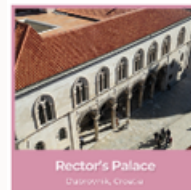

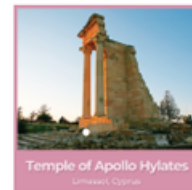

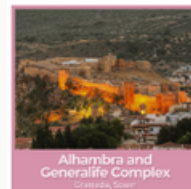
